

### Conferences, Meetings, Seminars & Continuing Medical Education (CME)



A **Workshop on Manuscript and Grant Writing** organized at the Visakhapatnam campus on 15 April 2018 for LVPEI's team of ophthalmologists, scientists, fellows and researchers, was led by Prof Jill Keeffe.

**Case Based Analysis & Interpretation of Visual Electro Diagnostic Tests** was organized on 8 April 2018 for 60 participants across all campuses



including faculty, fellows, residents, and 41 delegates, from India and abroad connected on webinar. Highlights included case based extensive interaction on interpretation and standardization of electrophysiological tests in the clinical context, followed by demonstration of the extended protocols related to visual electrodiagnostics.



The **8<sup>th</sup> Exit Competency Training program on Ocular Trauma** for comprehensive fellows and residents was organized at Visakhapatnam campus on 1 April 2018. Thirty two participants benefited from this training.

The workshop on **Corporate Entrepreneurship and Inspired Leadership through Personal Mastery**, 20-22 April 2018, was conducted by Dr DVR Seshadri, Clinical Professor, Indian School of Business (ISB). The focus was on training and motivating the select LVPEI team of participants to become extraordinary leaders.



Workshop on **Smart Phone Accessibility and Special Education** was organized for persons with vision loss by the Institute for Vision Rehabilitation at GMRV Campus on 21 April 2018. The workshop had 26 participants, who were oriented to assistive technology on 'Android' platform, basic navigation gestures using TalkBack and other basic applications like 'phone' and 'message'. Additionally, there was a session for parents of children with multiple disabilities about 'Importance of Special Education'.

## Social Impact

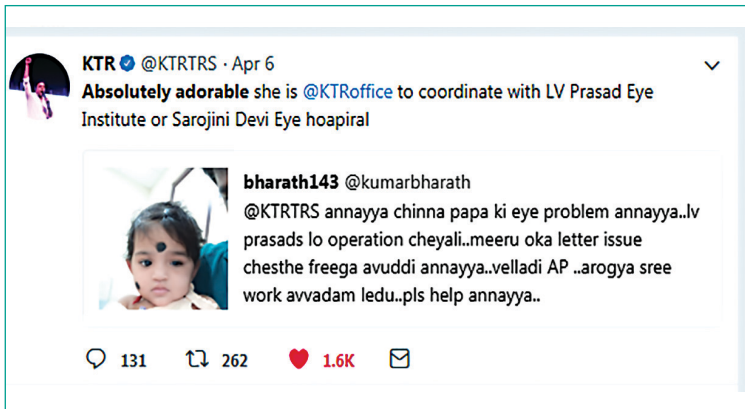
The following snapshot is a series of Tweets in the month of April regarding an ROP (Retinopathy of Prematurity) patient that received wide online appreciation.

**Tweet 2 on 6 April was from KTR - replying to baby's relative**

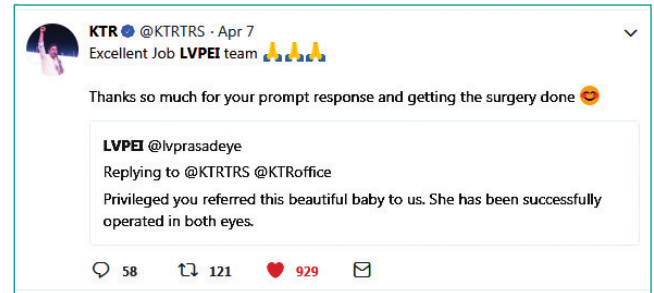


Baby was taken up for ROP surgery by Dr Subhadra Jalali the very next day.

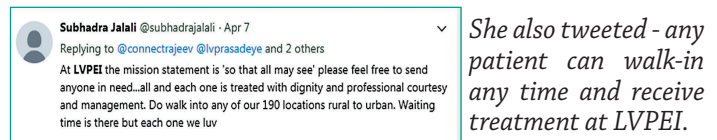
**Tweet 3 on 7 April was from LVPEI in reply to KTR**



**Tweet 4 on 7 April was from KTR in reply to LVPEI**

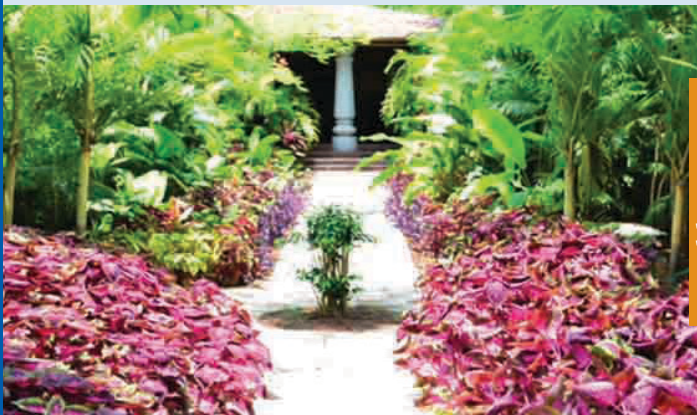


**Tweet 5 on 7 April was from Dr Jalali**
