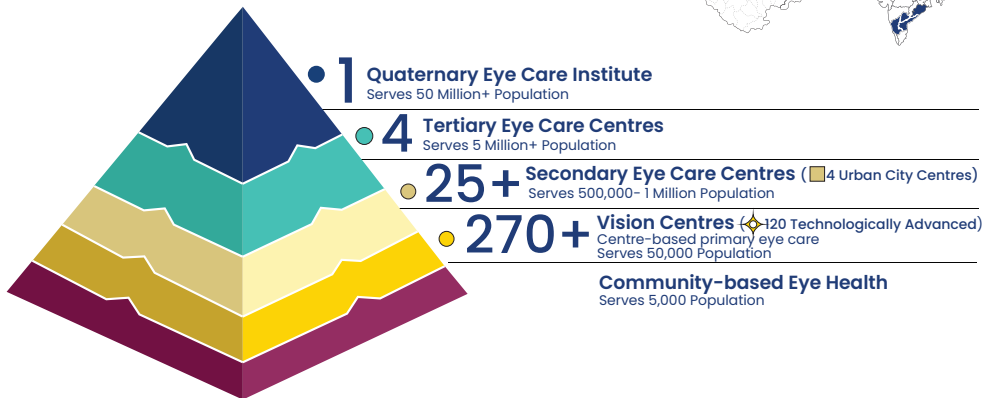
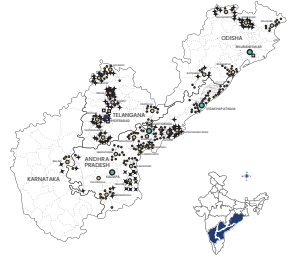

Community-based Eye Health

Vision Guardians conduct door-to-door eye screenings and refer people with issues to the nearest Vision Centre.

Vision Centres

Permanent primary eye care centres where trained technicians check for refractive errors, dispense eyeglasses, and connect patients to ophthalmologists via teleconsultation or refer to Secondary Centres if needed.

Secondary Eye Care Centres

Provide outpatient services and are equipped to perform surgeries for cataract, glaucoma, and some retinal conditions.

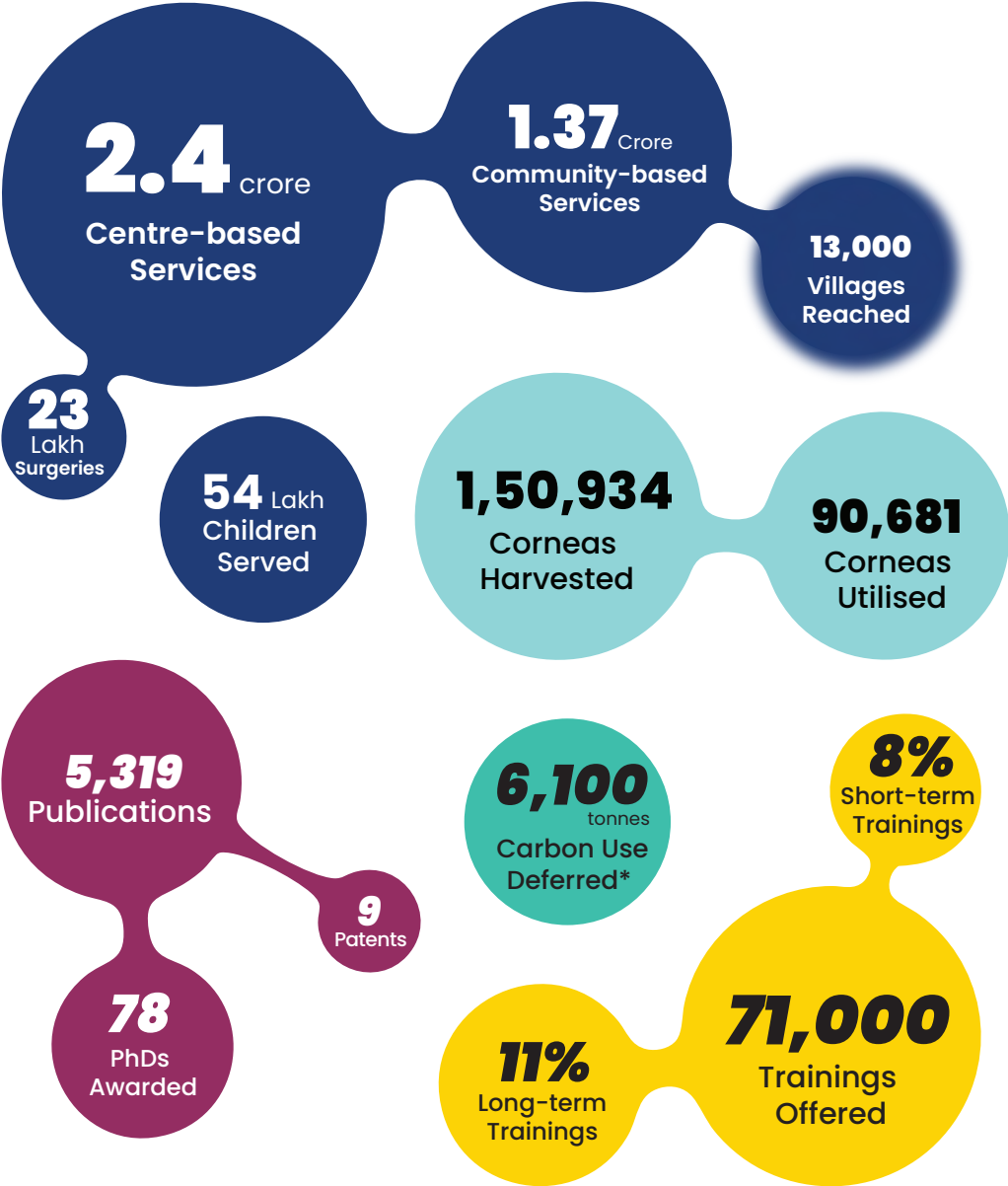
Tertiary Eye Care Centres

Advanced facilities offering complex eye surgeries and serving as clinical research sites.

Quaternary Eye Care Institute

Handles extremely complex cases and is home to all ten functional arms of the institute, offering expert care by ophthalmologists.

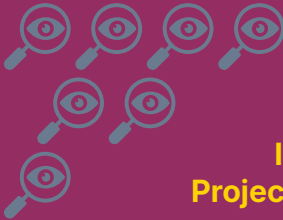
