Frequently asked questions

About the course and prospects:

01) Who is the right candidate for the course?

Ans: A candidate who has a passion for beginning and excelling in their career in optical retail after completing 12th Standard or intermediate with a science background.

02) There are several courses offered online and offline; why should I join this course provided by LVPEI?

Application and registration:

5) How shall I apply for the course.

Ans: Apply through the online link provided in the flyer or by visiting <u>www.lvpei.org</u> and choosing the link under <u>upcoming events</u>

6) What is the qualification needed for the course? Ans: 10th Std + (BiPC or MPC) with minimum 50% Pass.

7) Is the course online or on campus?

Ans: The course is on campus.

8) Would there be any entrance test?

Ans: No. There wouldn't be any entrance test. But, we interview candidates through a virtual platform.

9) When is the last date for application?

Ans: 31st August would be the last date for application

10) When does the course start

Ans: The course would start in September; Institute shall announce the start date to the registered candidates.

Facilities on campus for living:

11) Where is the accommodation and what type?

Ans: Institute provides shared accommodation on the campus premises. Separate blocks for boys and girls are available on campus.

12) What about the food?

Ans: Our campus has a canteen facility that serves only vegetarian food. Only vegetarian food is allowed inside the campus.

13) What if I would like to stay outside?

Ans: The candidate needs to stay in the accommodation provided by the LVPEI in the first year. There would not be any trade-off for accommodation and canteen services in the first year.

Facilities on campus for learning:

14) What educational resources are available?

Ans: Library and digital library with the state-of-the-art dispensing resource center for practical learning can train the candidate in all aspects.

Examinations:

15) How are the examinations conducted?

Ans: Performance is monitored weekly once without scoring. Examinations are conducted once in three months.

Break/Holidays:

16) How frequently do we get the breaks and holidays?

Ans: Institute would declare breaks during festivals and after the examinations from time to time.

Location during the course:

17) Where would the course be taught?

Ans: Institute conducts the theory and practical sessions at GPR, Kismathpur campus, Hyderabad. On-job training is done in the LVPEI optical retail in Hyderabad for the first year, and then the trainees would be posted across the LVPEI network in the second year (Hyderabad, Vishakhapatnam, Vijayawada, and Bhubaneswar)

18) What would be the timing of the sessions?

Ans: In the first year, between 9:30 AM to 5:00 PM. As per the operations of the retail stores in the second year.

Course Fee and sponsorship:

19) What is the fee for the course?

Ans: For the first year, it is 1, 30, 500 INR (Includes accommodation and food facility). For the second year, it is 1, 38, 500 INR.

20) Would there be any stipend or scholarship?

Ans: For the first year, the institute provides a monthly 500 INR stipend. In the second year, the stipend increases to 6,700 INR per month. The institute bears the official transportation charges. In the second year, accommodation and food facilities are taken care of by the trainee itself.

21) I cannot afford the course fee. But I am interested in the course. What shall I do?

Ans: We encourage you to apply and attend the interview if you are eligible for the course based on your qualification. There could be a possibility of sponsorship for under-privileged candidates.

Additional questions:

22) How is the certificate issued for the course?

Ans: SCB-Academy of Eye Care Education, L V Prasad Eye Institute issues the certificate to the candidate.

23) What if I discontinue the course in between.

Ans: The institute would not reimburse the course fee to the candidate would not provide either participation or course completion certificate.

24) Can I work while I take this course?

Ans; The course is full time and you cannot work offline or online.

25) What about the facility on the campus?

Ans: The campus is in South Hyderabad, which is fast growing. Accommodation and food facilities are within the premises of the campus. Hospitals, Banking and essentials are available around 4 km from the campus.

26) Is there any sports or recreational facility?

Ans: Indoor games are available. For recreational purposes, a television with a satellite cable connection is public, where the campus residents have access to it.
